

## **BEB13: CLINICAL TRIAL INFORMATION**

There is currently a clinical trial for Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) in Australia to study the effect of a new topical gel on wound healing. This is a randomized study including a double blinded phase of 90 days and an optional 2 year open label phase.

You may be eligible to participate in this clinical trial if:

1. You are four years of age or older
2. You have been diagnosed with any genetic form of EB
3. You have chronic wounds
4. You are willing to follow the requirements of the study, including:
  - application of the topical gel to the skin with each dressing change (so long as the gel is applied at least every 4 days)
  - attendance at the investigating centre for regular study visits for the duration of the trial

Transportation will be reimbursed.

This study is now open for recruitment for adults and children with EB.
